 - Spring predictions show progress
 - Internal interventions have seen students taken out of other lessons to improve on English & Maths
 - Intervention strategies in place
 - 169 students accessing lesson 7

Q: (SM) Once AP have been removed from the data, is there a specific cohort impacting on the numbers?

PS: Yes and SISRA has allowed us to identify and track students so we can offer them the support they need

Q: (SM) I understand it's too early to monitor the intervention strategies for progress but do you have anything anecdotal that makes you think we are seeing some improvements?

PS: When we spoke to students who have attended both English & Maths, they speak about being in a smaller group is more successful for them and if we track that number from their mock in October we can see, roughly, the grade 9-5 measure is showing a 3% increase from October to February and we are predicting a 6% increase based on that Spring mock

Q: (SM) Do you do any sharing in learning with other Trust schools?

PS: Yes we do and we benefit from the fact we have Angela (Murphy, Academy Improvement Team) based here for a couple of days every week and from Amanda (Welsh) & Richard (Hill) lower down in the school

C: (PS) As the vocational classes come to an end, more time can be given to English and Maths

C: (CS) A lot is ad-hoc intervention, as they finish we look at the here and now

C: (MB) We need to be mindful of balance and lesson 7 is the right thing to offer

Q: (DB) Have you amended the assessment programme at all?

PS: This is the first full exam post-covid and all removed elements have been restored. The boundaries are close to 2019 and we might have to under promise and over deliver

C: (PS) We know that English and Maths is vital but we need to look beyond those to EBacc

Q: (DB) English interventions have doubled. Does English unlock the way for everything else? PS: Yes and we have good input from the English staff

Q: (DB) It's a lot, how do you fit it all in?

PS: We have a different breed of teacher at Winifred Holtby, we care greatly and just want them to do well. We have a low staff turnover so can also offer that stability. Our teachers are also prepared to stay late

C: (MB) To go back to David's question regarding assessment, we are currently on a journey developing assessment practice and have built safety nets into the papers. We also have staff delivering a lesson 8

C: (BH) Speaking as a teacher, we are happy to do whatever it takes

C: (CS) We have made sure all who want to access the lessons can do. Anxiety has been a barrier, we need to make them feel comfortable before they even come in

C: (VT) I think you have delivered a clear message for Year 11 outcomes. Thank you, Pete & Craig, for a good presentation. Lesson 7 for Year 10 is excellent, the timetabling for lesson 7 is excellent. Please pass on our thanks to senior leaders and all involved
