Dear Parents and Carers

You will have no doubt seen recent announcements by the government in relation to the wearing of face coverings in schools. I would like to provide you with the following update.

From Monday 17th May 2021, we will be following Government Guidance and removing the requirement for students to wear a face covering in lessons. However, if your child would like to continue to wear a face covering in lessons they will be supported to do so. Local infection guidance suggests that there remains a significant benefit to wearing a face covering in communal spaces such as corridors and dining areas. Therefore we will be following this guidance and expecting all students, unless medically exempt, to wear a face covering in communal spaces until we are advised that this is no longer recommended.

In addition, we would strongly advise students in Year 11 to continue to wear a face covering in both classrooms and communal areas within the academy as we aim to ensure that they are able to continue to work towards providing the evidence towards their Centre Assessed Grades within the academy.
